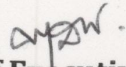

Circular No: 144 C

Subject: Procedure to be followed for acceptance of scheme and it's verification of overlapping of proposed Slum Rehabilitation Scheme boundary on GIS base map.

1. As per Circular No 144 dated 31.08.2013, the SR Scheme (Annexure I to V) is submitted to the Engineering Department of SRA. Before submission of the SR Scheme, Head Clerk (Engineering Department) manually verifies overlapping of the proposed SR Scheme boundary with available data. Accordingly SR schemes are either rejected or accepted for further processing.
2. As per Circular No 144-B dated 28th December 2015, Society /Developer/ Architect etc. is required to submit the Slum Rehabilitation Scheme boundary in the GIS format and hard copy of plan along with SR scheme proposal. The GIS data with DGPS processing report containing Baseline network, Photo of DGPS point and Coordinates are to be submitted in properly tagged Compact Disc (CD) in 3 (Three) sets to Engineering Department, SRA. Out of these 3 CDs Engineering Department will forward 1 CD each to IT Department and DSLR Department respectively.
3. Based on submitted GIS data of the proposed SR schemes, IT Department with the help of GIS Cell shall verify the overlapping of proposed SR Scheme boundary on GIS base map and shall submit the report to Engineering Department as **Annexure VI** for further processing of the proposal.
4. Annexure I to V of SR Scheme proposal will only be processed further after receiving Annexure VI report from IT Department.
5. **The amendment and the instructions of this circular will come in force with effect from 1st Jun 2016.**
